MINUTES

The Tom Green County Bail Bond Board met on Wednesday, January 15, 2025 in the County Commissioner's court room.

Item Number 1 was to call the meeting to order and the determination of a quorum. Board Chair Dianna Spieker called the meeting to order at 11:00AM and acknowledged that a quorum was present.

Item Number 2 was the Consent Agenda. This consisted of the Minutes from the October 16, 2024 and November 13, 2024 meetings and the Bond Issuance Monthly Report. Judge Jay Daniel made a motion to approve such. Billy Fiveash seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion passed.

Item Number 3 was to consider any submitted renewal bail bond applications within the 30-day window. 24/7 Louie Perez Bail Bonds was under this agenda item. The application was presented by Dianna Spieker and announced that all criteria has been submitted satisfactorily and there are no issues. MINUTES

The Tom Green County Bail Bond Board met on Wednesday, April 16, 2025 in the County Commissioner's court room.

Item Number 1 was to call the meeting to order and the determination of a quorum. Board Chair Dianna Spieker called the meeting to order at 11:01AM and Louie Perez acknowledged that a quorum was present.

Item Number 2 was the Consent Agenda. This consisted of the Minutes from the January 15, 2025 meeting and the Bond Issuance Monthly Report. Christina Ubando made a motion to approve. Jason Sosa seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion passed.

Freedom Bail Bonds II was audited on April 7, 2025 and there were no issues. With Alliance Bail Bonds, there was an issue found with regards to "transfer" bonds. Four (4) files were not in compliance with the audit team and questions were brought to the bail bond board for clarification. Upon further discussion and explanation about the nature of transfer bonds, every bail bond company would be put on notice that all bail bonds, including transfer bonds, will need to be completed in full and fully open to inspection as any other bail bond. A motion was made by Jason Sosa to allow "grace" for Alliance Bail Bonds temporarily and follow up with another audit sometime this year. If any problems and/or issues arise from this audit, measures may be taken up at that time. Christina Ubando seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion passed. Furthermore, a subsequent motion was made by Judge Stacye Speck to accept the results for 24/7 Louie Perez Bail Bonds and Freedom Bail Bonds II. Christina Ubando seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion passed.

The Tom Green County Bail Bond Board met on Wednesday, October 15, 2025 in the County Commissioner's court room.

Item Number 1 was to call the meeting to order and the determination of a quorum. Board Chair Dianna Spieker called the meeting to order at 11:00AM and Secretary Louie Perez acknowledged that a quorum was present.

Item Number 2 was the Consent Agenda. This consisted of 2(a) the Minutes from the July 16, 2025 meeting and the 2(b) the Bond Issuance Monthly Report. Louie Perez advised the board that the minutes were not available from the July 16, 2025 meeting; therefore, the minutes were tabled until the next meeting.
