MINUTES

The Tom Green County Bail Bond Board met on Wednesday, January 21, 2026 in the County Commissioner's court room.

Item Number 1 was to call the meeting to order and the determination of a quorum. Board Chair Dianna Spieker called the meeting to order at 11:00AM. Board Secretary Louie Perez took roll and acknowledged that a quorum was present.

Item Number 2 was the Consent Agenda. This consisted of the (a) Minutes from the November 19, 2025 meeting, the (b) Bond Issuance Monthly Report. Judge Stacye Speck made a motion to approve said items. Christina Ubando seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion passed.

Item Number 3 was to consider any renewal bail bond applications within the 30-day window. None.

Item Number 4 was to consider bail bond audits. None.

Item Number 5 was to consider a request for the release of the collateral for Texas Outlaw Bail Bonds. Dianna Spieker informed the board members that all business has been concluded and all liability has been properly satisfied with the afore-mentioned bail bond company. Furthermore, the Fifty thousand dollar (\$50,000.00) Certificate of Deposit that is currently in escrow with the Tom Green County Treasurer may now be released. Joe Losoya made a motion to release the collateral and Judge Stacye Speck seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the motion passed.

Item Number 6 was to consider a briefing from the bail bond companies. Louie Perez reported that the bail bondsmen had two (2) meetings. One in December and another one in January. Some of the items discussed were: proposed new bail bond forms, a new record requirement form, audit updates, proposed new rules for 2026 and procedure changes.

Item Number 7 was to consider Rules and Forms Revisions. The current Bail Bond Rules and Regulations have been in effect since July 20, 2022. The Rules Committee have proposed the following revisions. Said revisions were going to be presented in sections and in staying within the rules; the sections would be ratified in order and approved consecutively.
