Failure to Answer Summons and Penalties: A person who fails to comply with this summons is subject to a contempt action punishable by a

juror. An employee whose employment is terminated in violation of this section is entitled to return to the same employment that the employee held when summoned for jury service if the employee, as soon as practical after release from jury service, gives the employer actual notice that the

employee intends to return. (Civil Practice and Remedies Code, Section 122.001).
